

# Become a Mentor

## Fundamental Gymnastics Coach Pathway

Becoming a Gymnastics Australia Club Coach Educator (CCE) is a rewarding key leadership role, focused on fostering participant-centred coaching practices, integrity, and inclusivity.

Eligible coaches must demonstrate at minimum, a current Technical Membership, be engaged with a Gymnastics Australia affiliated club, and hold any Intermediate GymSport coaching qualification.

The application involves submitting an online expression of interest, reviewed by the State and Territory Association. Once approved, CCE candidates can access the CCE Accreditation in Flex.

This involves a concise Online Course and a 3-hour Virtual Induction, where a member of the Gymnastics Australia Mentor Panel works with candidates to explain their role and the relevant responsibilities.

This structured learning journey equips CCEs to understand their roles in developing a new coach's readiness for independent coaching. Gymnastics Australia values the trust and responsibility integral to the CCE role. CCEs benefit from membership in an online Community of Practice, fostering an ongoing supportive environment.

Any currently qualified supervisors must also complete the CCE course, current Presenter and Assessors will receive an exemption for the Virtual Induction component.

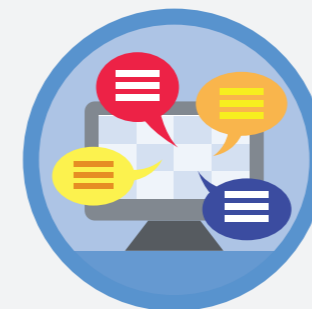
### 1 Apply Now!

It's free to express your interest in becoming a CCE. Minimum age is 18 to undertake the Accreditation.



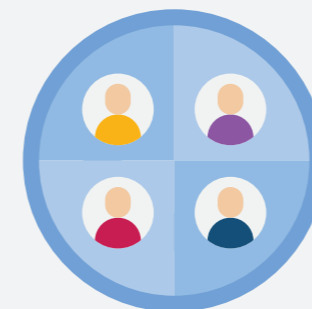
### 2 Start Learning Journey
